April Membership Report

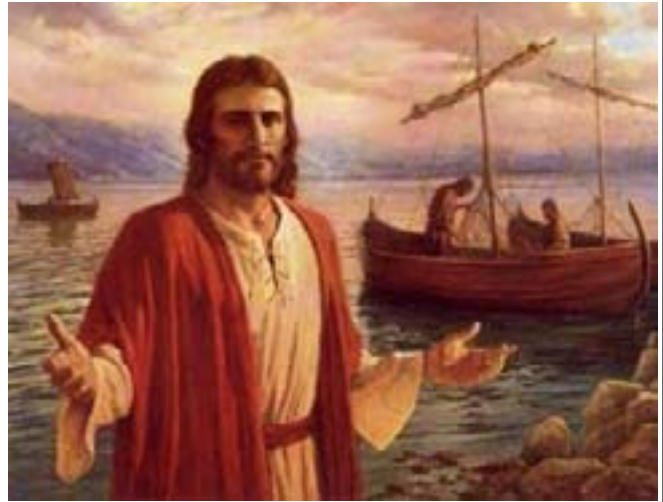
Thank you Brother Knights for your support and volunteering on Sunday April 17th last, when our Council hosted the Parish Hospitality Sunday.

The membership blitz resulted in identifying a number of candidates which we hope will take their First Degree on May 16th.

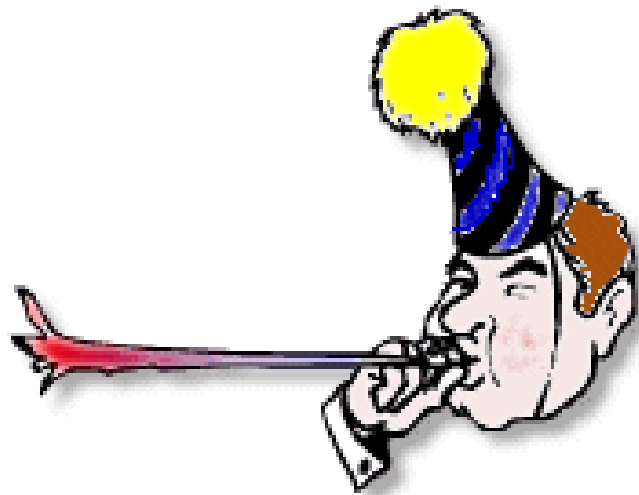
A reminder to all-First Degree Knights to keep Saturday May 28th open in order that you may take your Major Degrees which will be held at St. Cecilia Parish Hall.
