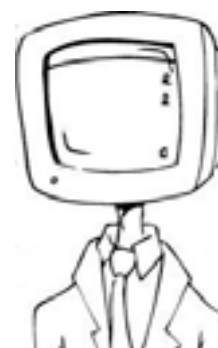

We are once again making a month-long appeal in October to the Parishioners of St. Bonaventure to donate items to support the **Mustard Seed Street Ministry** in its charitable endeavors. The items most needed are termed 'Wish List' items.

The items on the Wish List marked 'Urgent' are: disposable razors, mittens/gloves, new underwear, feminine products, jeans, warm clothing, new socks and toothbrushes. Although not in the 'Urgent' category, bus tickets are also requested. With them, the Mustard Seed's destitute residents can accept employment in any part of the city and get on their feet sooner. Paula Bannerman, Volunteer Coordinator, told me that bus tickets will be in short supply soon as they open their Temporary Winter Shelter in November.

We are again being aided in our efforts by Brookfield Properties, Petro-Canada Centre, who kindly puts a similar appeal in their bulletin to their tenants. We were able to collect substantially more items in last year's drives with their help and we are hoping for similar results this time.

That Sunday is World Youth Day and to mark the occasion, we will support the Youth as they prepare and serve the Community Meal at the Mustard Seed. The recommended group size is 8 persons per shift. The Mustard Seed requires a ratio of 1 adult for every 3 Youth meaning that, for each shift, we need 2 Knights to drive 6 Youth and to work with them while they are there. Please consider volunteering for this opportunity to help the Youth broaden their life perspective and help the 'Seed feed the homeless.

HISTORY OF THE KNIGHTS

The Knights of Columbus was founded in 1882 by a 29-year-old parish priest, Fr. Michael J. McGivney, in the basement of St. Mary's Church in New Haven, CT. Today, more than a century later, the Knights of Columbus has become the largest lay organization in the Catholic Church.

The Order has been called "the strong right arm of the Church," and has been praised by popes, presidents and other world leaders, for support of the Church, programs of evangelization and Catholic education, civic involvement and aid to those in need. Founded during era of anti-Catholic bigotry, the Knights has championed religious rights throughout its 121-year history.

Since it was incorporated on March 29, 1882, the Knights of Columbus has grown from several members in one council to more than 12,000 councils and over 1.6 million members throughout the United States, Canada, the Philippines, Mexico, the Dominican Republic, Puerto Rico, Panama, the Bahamas, the Virgin Islands, Guatemala, Guam and Saipan.
