Red Stage #1 - Discuss what the phrase “You are the Church” means to you. What are you doing to be part of the Church?

Red Stage #4 - Discuss what living as a Catholic in today’s society entails. Compare your personal beliefs and ideas against those which are strongly held by the Catholic Church. Points for consideration include: politics, war/peace, justice, education, equality and current events.

Discuss “What if Jesus came back today?”

- How would he come into the world?
- What class of society will he be in?
- How would he make himself known?
- What other religions believe in him?
- Will Catholics believe in him?
- What if Jesus came as a woman?
- What would be his greatest miracle?
- Would you really believe that he was the Christ? Why or why not?

Red Stage #2 - Outside - Read the Acts of the Apostles.

- Select one chapter from this book and present a short synopsis.
- What effect did the Holy Spirit have on the characters and events?
- Give one or two examples of how this is similar to a recent (within the last 100 years) occurrence.

Red Stage #6 - Lead in Scout/Guide program discussion.

- How can the promise and law help you to be a good Christian. (Help and serve God, community, citizenship and environment)?
